

**ORDINANCE NO. 25-1751**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORWALK AMENDING NORWALK  
MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17.03.170 REGARDING EXEMPT SIGNS**

**WHEREAS**, the Norwalk Municipal Code establishes sign regulations in Article III of Section 17.03.170;

**WHEREAS**, Section 17.03.170 identifies signs that are permitted in all zones subject to compliance with specific requirements;

**WHEREAS**, the language in Section 17.03.170(G)(4) relating to Political Signs requires clarification.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWALK DOES ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 17.03.170(G)(4) of the Norwalk Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

“Signs placed upon the public right-of-way are expressly prohibited and will be removed by the City. If the sign is placed in such a manner as to obscure traffic signs or signals or obstruct vehicle operators’ line of sight they are subject to immediate removal by City staff.”

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption. The City Clerk is directed to certify to the enactment of this Ordinance and to cause this ordinance to be published and/or posted as required by law.
