3. PRECISE DEVELOPMENT PLAN NO. 2023-06

Ben Martin, Rexford Industrial Realty LP (“Applicant”); a request to demolish two existing multi-tenant industrial warehouse buildings totaling 89,870 square feet to construct a new 138,972 square foot industrial warehouse building with off-street parking, landscaping improvements, and associated infrastructure on a 7.03-acre lot located at 14830 Carmenita Road (Assessor’s Parcel Number (APN) 8069-002-085), in the Heavy Manufacturing (M2) zone. The proposed building would include 132,227 square feet of warehouse space, 3,715 square feet of ground-floor office space, and 3,030 square feet of mezzanine office space.

Environmental: Review and adoption of Mitigated Negative Declaration with the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan.

Staff Recommendation: That the Planning Commission:

- (1) Adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration with the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan contained therein; and
- (2) Adopt Resolution No. 24-13, to approve Precise Development Plan (PDP) No. 2023-06 subject to the Conditions of Approval contained in Exhibit “A”.

Planning Commission Action: Continued to the Special Planning Commission Meeting of February 12, 2025, as requested by the applicant, on a vote of 3-0.
