



California Levine Act Statement

California Government Code Section 84308, commonly referred to as the "Levine Act," prohibits any Norwalk City Council Member from participating in any action related to a contract or application if he or she receives any political contributions totaling more than \$250 within the previous twelve months, and for three months following the date a final decision from the business or applicant.

The Levine Act also requires a member of the Norwalk City Council who has received such a contribution to disclose the contribution on the record of the proceeding.


